Dear Friends,

NEVER GIVE UP PRAYING

I am so blessed to live 2 minutes from the seafront, and I love it. It's my go to place to be with Jesus. Whatever time of year, I love to walk along the prom and praise him and pray. As I look out to sea, even with the traffic behind me and people chatting, it's a place I can always find real peace to converse with Jesus. One conversation we have repeatedly is about one of my sons. I have prayed for him since before he was born and he loved Jesus until he was about 14 or 15 then he went as far away from Him as possible. I have never stopped asking our faithful Lord to draw him back.

My son is now 34 and 2 years ago he visited Bali, where he had "what I can only describe as a vision" - my son's words. I immediately felt it was from God, but he was reluctant to accept that, preferring to say he'd connected with Mother Nature, but he is beginning to realise God is at work! The vision was a huge tree coming towards him and teaching him that energy (good or bad) is transferable between all living things, not just humankind, but trees, plants & animals too. The tree went on to say that nature naturally aborbs humanity's energy output, which is increasingly one of anger & greed and not love, but that music can bring great healing. The result of this is that my son, a music producer, now works with plants to produce music. Plants & trees, living things, produce a vibration that matches that of a human when s/he is showing unconditional love. When tiny electrodes are placed on a plant's leaf or petal, it produces music which can be played through a sound system.

Plants also make a more beautiful sound if you tell them you love them, and they stop or make a terrible noise if you say you hate them! These are God's beautiful creation. When the plants produce their music, a connection is made between them and the people around, and the connected vibrations are raised, which in turn produces a higher level of love. This project is called Natural Symphony and my son was invited to play his plants this year at many venues, including The Royal Chelsea Flower Show, Glastonbury and the Barbican. God is doing great things in him and my son talks about the need for love and healing in the world through nature and music. He is passionate about his work and is a young man full of love and the need to spread it. He now allows me to say "you know this is God's works, don't you?" and he smiles and half nods.....we're getting there. I'll keep praying and I hope this testimony inspires you to never give up praying for your loved ones. God is using my son in an amazing way. **Debbie Dean.**

6th November -for he Lord your God goes with you....Deut 31:6

A family were on the beach enjoying the sunshine, mum & dad watching their daughter play. 13th November - Walk in love: Eph 5:2

The Greeks used 4 words for love: **Storge** (affection), **Eros** (sexual attraction), **Philia** (friendship) & **Agape** (unconditional, sacrificial love). When the bible talks about God's love for us & the love we should have for him and others, the word used is always Agape. It's difficult to love people we don't like (but not impossible!), and God will sometimes bring hard-to-love people into our lives. He didn't feel fondness for the Pharisees! We don't have to *like* everyone – phew! – but we *must* love them. The bible tells us how to 'walk in love'. Like physical walking this unconditional love takes effort and practice, every day.
