Fri	3 <sup>rd</sup>	Thank God for all forms of transport, bike, car, bus, train and planes.
Sat	4 <sup>th</sup>	Praise God for winter sunshine.
Sun	5 <sup>th</sup>	Thank God for your church, for Tongayi and Rudo, for your church friends.
Mon	6 <sup>th</sup>	Thank God for all you <b>must</b> do this week and all you <b>choose</b> to do this week.
Tues	7 <sup>th</sup>	Thank God for whatever is outside your window, even if it's a rainy morning!

Wed	8 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for an end to the war in the Ukraine, for God's power to change hard hearts.
Thurs	9 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for the people in Afghanistan: hunger is soaring and 97% of the population are sinking into poverty.
Fri	10 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for an end to conflict in Gaza and Israel.
Sat	11 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for countries affected this year by storms.
Sun	12 <sup>th</sup>	<b>REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY:</b> pray for soldiers engaged in conflicts around the world: those who willingly signed up and those ordered to, and for their loved ones.
Mon	13 <sup>th</sup>	Pray about the effect of climate change and how we might do our bit to help. Pray for world leaders who have the power to make changes.
Tues	14 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for our own Government.
<b>Merciful God, pour out your powerful, cleansing love on those hard hearts and cause change. Lord in your mercy, hear our prayers.</b>

Wed	15 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for those who live either side of you, and a neighbour you are grateful for.

Fri	17 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for those in your street who are unwell, awaiting surgery, have received a recent diagnosis.
Sat	18 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for the elderly, the lonely, the bereaved.
Sun	19 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for local charities/foodbanks that are stretched more than ever under the current circumstances.
Mon	20 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for places that have opened a 'warm space' to offer to those who need it.
Tues	21 <sup>st</sup>	Pray for all who will need to ask for help this winter.
