Sun 4 th	For church services online, on paper, on TV and radio. A day of rest, to reflect, give thanks and sit with Jesus.
Mon 5 th	For your friends and local community.
Tues 6 th	For doctors, nurses, paramedics, and all other hospital staff.
Wed 7 th	For all shop workers, banks, services to our homes: postal/refuse/supermarket deliveries.

Thurs 8 th	Anyone we know who is currently in hospital.
Fri 9 th	Those we know who are unwell.
Sat 10 th	People in the world without basic human rights.
