Psalm 107	A week of thanksgiving prayer:
Fri 1 st	On World Day of Prayer, please pray for peace, justice and freedom of religion and movement. Pray for women, refugees, the sick, dying and grieving.
Sat 2 nd	Thank God for the spot where you are now, a cosy armchair, a dining chair where you sit and eat, a warm room.....thank Jesus that He is there with you!
Sun 3 rd	A day of rest, to reflect, give thanks and sit with Jesus.
Mon 4 th	Give thanks for the gift of a new week, new opportunities to be loving and kind as Jesus taught us.
Tues 5 th	For our churches and all who serve in them, bringing us a variety of worship.
Wed 6 th	Give thanks for all the fellowship groups, clubs and activities our churches offer.
Thurs 7 th	Give thanks that Spring is around the corner as we spot the signs of new life.

Phil 4:5	A week of prayer for healing:
Fri 8 th	Those with 'flu, chest infections and viruses that are affecting so many both in hospital and at home.
Sat 9 th	Those we know with illnesses that require hospital treatments and for those currently in hospital.
Sun 10 th	Mothering Sunday: "Loving Jesus, thank you for all mothers, grandmothers, daughters, sisters and friends who offer us love and care."
Mon 11 th	For all families living with fractured relationships.
Tues 12 th	For all those living with pain or struggling with anxiety and worry.
Wed 13 th	For those who are grieving, that they will find God's love and peace.
Thurs 14 th	Those living without God.

Fri 15 th	For climate change, effects of plastic in our seas, pollution.

Mark 16	Prayers at Easter
